Access to Free WiFi is growing but how do you know that when you and your children connect to it that is automatically filtered? The Friendly WiFi symbol has been created in collaboration with The UK Council for Child Internet Safety (UKCCIS), initiated by Government and WiFi providers after concerns were raised by leading child safety charities that children and young people were being put at risk of viewing and accessing inappropriate material when using public WiFi. The 'Friendly WiFi' symbol is designed to help children, young people and adults know that the WiFi they are connecting to is filtered and independently accredited. KEEN GARDENERS WANTED

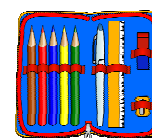
We are looking for volunteers to make Waulud Primary School a more greener and beautiful place for your children. If you are a keen gardener and have a few hours to spare please contact the school office.
