TOP TIPS

Dealing with inappropriate 'Recommended' and 'Up Next' videos on YouTube

YouTube is a great online resource with lots of fantastic, free learning videos. But sometimes the videos that are listed in the 'Recommended' and 'Up Next' sections are NOT SUITABLE. They are the result of algorithms which sit in the back ground looking at what you are searching for and looking at.

There are a few things you can do to help what is listed

Go to the YouTube Home page and at the top you will see the recommended videos. You will see 3 little dots at the middle right of each video. For any you don't want, click on the dots and click 'Not Interested' You can then say why.

Have a look through the YouTube history with your child every so often to see what they have watched in the past. Just go to youtube.com and on the left hand side (or at the bottom if you're viewing via an app), click on 'History'. For any that are inappropriate, just click on the X.

To completely reset everything forget the steps above and simply click on 'Clear all Watch History' and 'Clear all Search History'. Remember: this isn't a solution, you will have to repeat this every so often.



Bumped Heads

Should your child have a bump to the head during the school day you will be notified by a text message. Your child will be given the necessary treatment by a first aid trained, member of staff.

Should we feel your child's injury is a cause of concern you will be contacted by phone to advise you to seek further medical treatment or to take your child home.

Sickness Absence

If your child is absent from school due to sickness, this must be reported to the school office by 10am every day your child is absent.

If your child is absent for 5 consecutive days you will be required to provide the school with medical evidence, this can be a note from the doctor or we would like to see the medication your child has been prescribed, when they return to school.
