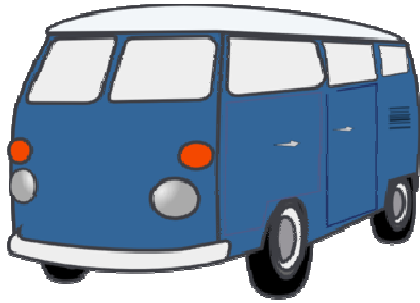

We do understand sometimes there can be exceptional circumstances and you have to take your child out of school, in these cases you must:

- Arrange an appointment to meet with the Headteacher.
- If you are travelling abroad we need to see evidence of flights and when the booking was made.
- You also need to complete "Leave of Absence" form.

Any child taken out of school without requesting Leave of Absence from school will be reported to the Local Authority as "CHILD MISSING IN EDUCATION" which could result in losing your child's place at school.

The National average for attendance is 95.5%. As a school we have a set target of 96.5%, we hope you will work with us to achieve this.
