You will find the tags on the green recycling bins.

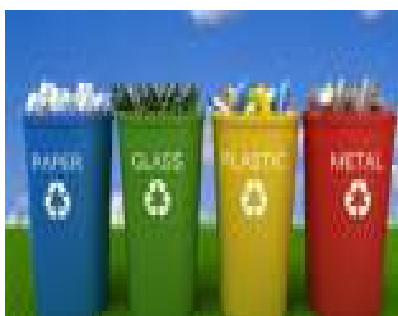
Please collect the Bin Tags each week and bring them into school.

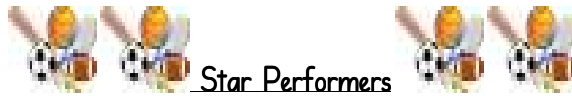
End of Term – Thursday 20th July 2017

Computing and Online Safety TOP TIPS

Ransomware is a type of malware that accesses files, locks and encrypts them and then demands ransom to the victim to get them back. The Malware often come in via email. Cybercriminals try to get users to click on attachments or links that appear legitimate but contain malicious code.

What can you do and what should you telling your children

STOP – THINK – CONNECT

Keep software, computer and mobile operating systems, security software and other frequently used programs and apps up to date.

- Turn on two-step authentication / verification on accounts where available.
- Back up your valuable work, music, photos and other digital information.
- Make sure you use strong passwords. True using phrases or sentences that are easy to remember.
- If you are unsure about a link in an email, even if it is from a known source, delete it.
- Scan USBs and other external devices before using them.
