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School Policy

Purpose

Waulud Primary School recognises that wearing a school uniform

- Promotes a sense of pride in our school community
- Helps to create a sense of community and belonging
- Identifies the pupil with the school
- Supports our commitment to inclusion
- Prevents pupils wearing clothes that could be a distraction in class
- Is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind
- Meets health and Safety guidelines

We expect pupils to present an appropriate appearance (including dress, hair, jewellery etc.) during the whole school day and on their way to and from school.

Parents and Carers' Responsibilities

We believe that one of the responsibilities of parents and carers is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the pupil's name is written on all items. If a parent or carer has difficulties for any reason with fulfilling this expectation they are asked to speak confidentially to a senior leader or Family Worker to discuss the issues. Parents or carers of pupils who arrive in school wearing non-uniform clothing will be contacted to discuss the matter and may be asked to bring in a PE kit.

Uniform List

Uniform
Plain grey trousers, plain grey skirt or pinafore dress
Plain yellow polo shirt with Waulud Primary School logo
Royal Blue sweatshirt or cardigan with Waulud Primary logo
Black, white, grey socks or leggings
Blue, grey or white headscarf
Plain Black Shoes
PE Kit
Plain white T-Shirt
Plain black leggings or jogging trousers
Plain black shorts
Plain black hoodie with Waulud Primary logo
Trainers
Year 4 Swimming Kit
Tight fitting swimming trunks or one piece swimming costume and towel

In order to participate fully in P.E. lessons, pupils must wear an appropriate P.E. kit as listed above. All school uniform and P.E. kit must be named. Pupils are to wear their P.E. kit to school on the days that a pupil has P.E. Trainers are to be worn with a P.E. kit to support pupils' feet during lessons in an appropriate way. Long hair should be tied back on P.E. days. No hair accessories, such as bands or hair bows, should be worn on P.E. days due to health and safety considerations.

The P.E. kit is part of the school uniform and should be considered as important as wearing uniform during other lessons.

Jewellery

No jewellery should be worn for P.E. or swimming. If ear piercings are to be worn, they should be small studs. No hoops or long earrings are permitted to be worn due to health and safety reasons. New ear piercings should be restricted to the longer school holidays to allow for safe removal as no jewellery may be worn for P.E. or swimming.

Hair

Long hair must be tied up on P.E. days. No large bows or hairbands with accessories are to be worn as they block the view of other children sitting behind the child wearing this.

Make up

Make up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform and safeguarding requirements.

Second Hand and Uniform Exchange

Periodically at school a second-hand uniform sale will take place, this will be available to all parents.
