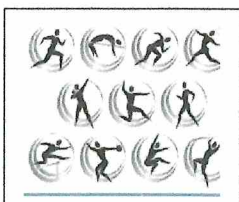
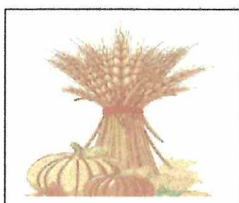

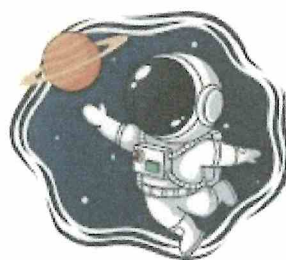
Harvest Assembly & Food Bank Trip

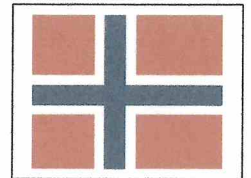
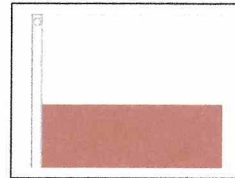
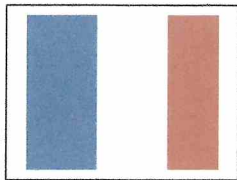
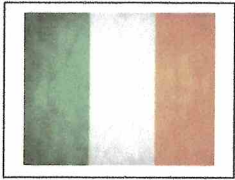


Year 5 Space Centre – 5th October

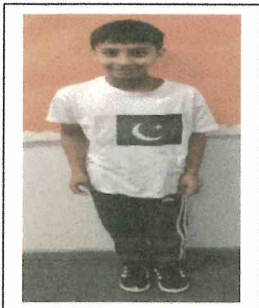
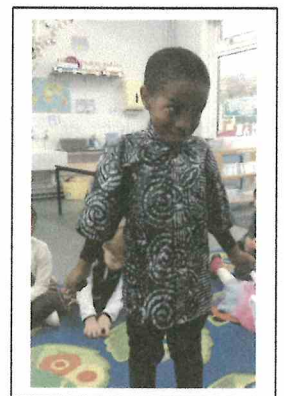
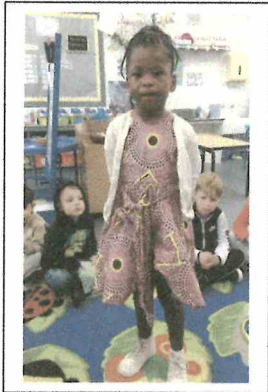
Children enjoyed many visitors and events throughout the week based on the Country they were learning about.

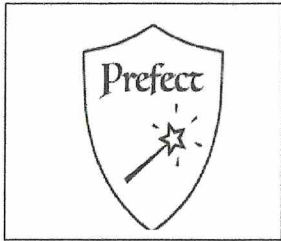

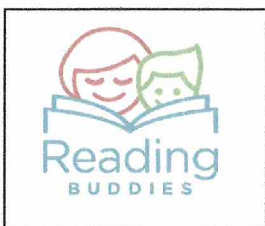
